Locate the following cities: Glasgow, Edinburgh, Newcastle, Leeds, Manchester, Liverpool, Sheffield, Birmingham, Cardiff, Bristol and London. Draw the main railway lines. Answer: How does the railway network relate to the population density seen in **Map 2**?

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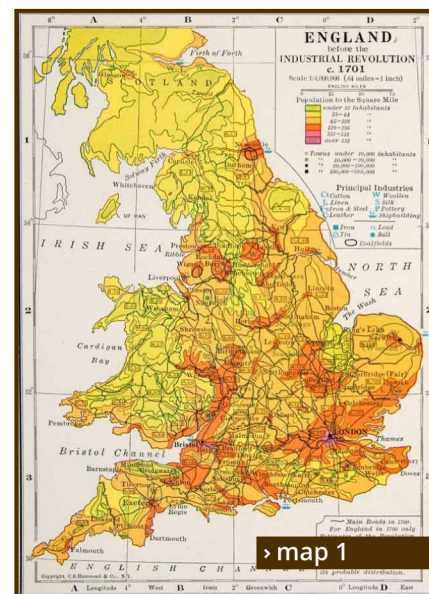
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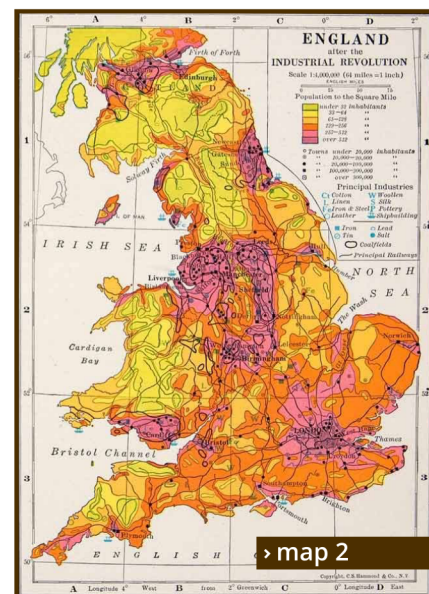
