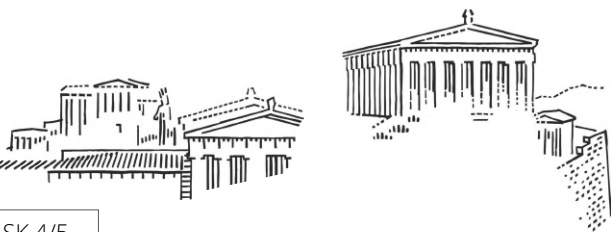


LIFE IN ANCIENT GREECE
