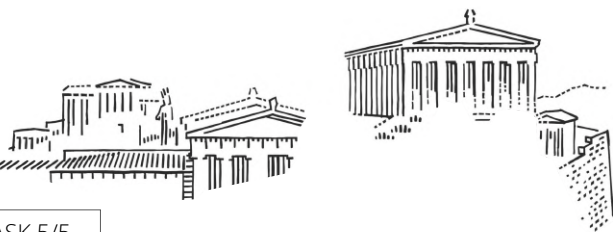

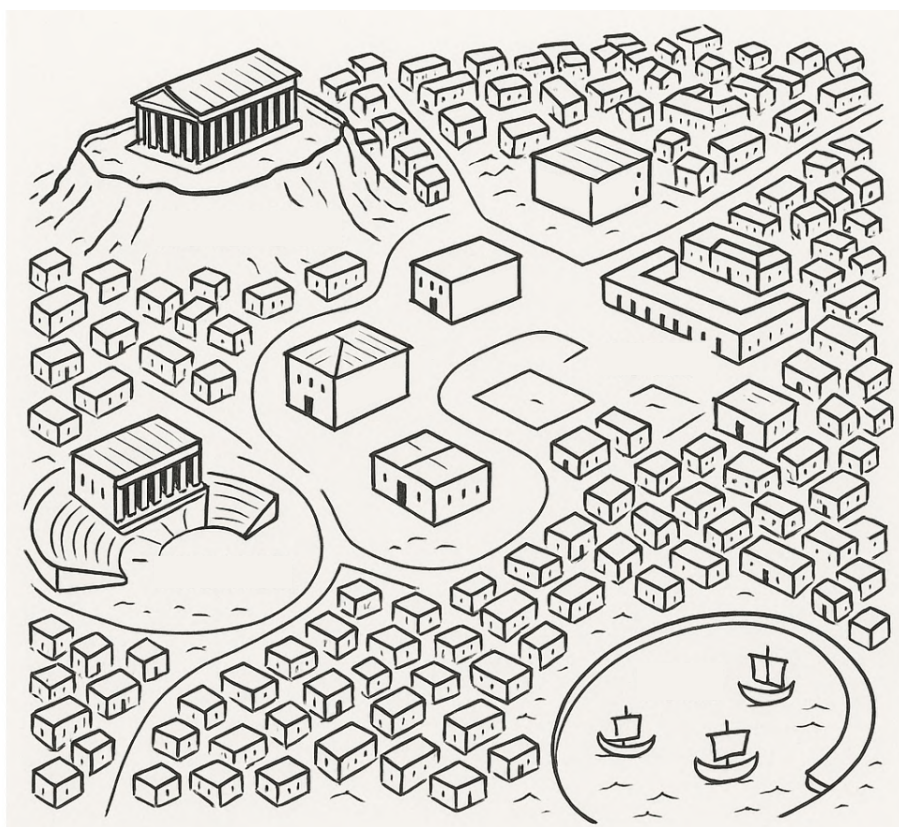
CHARACTER: **ANTIOPE**
