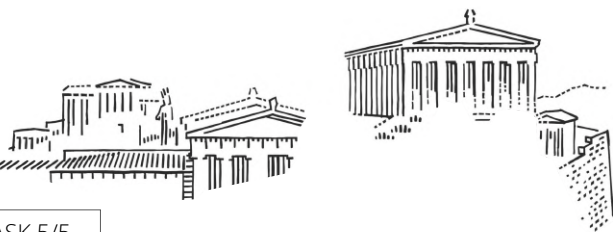

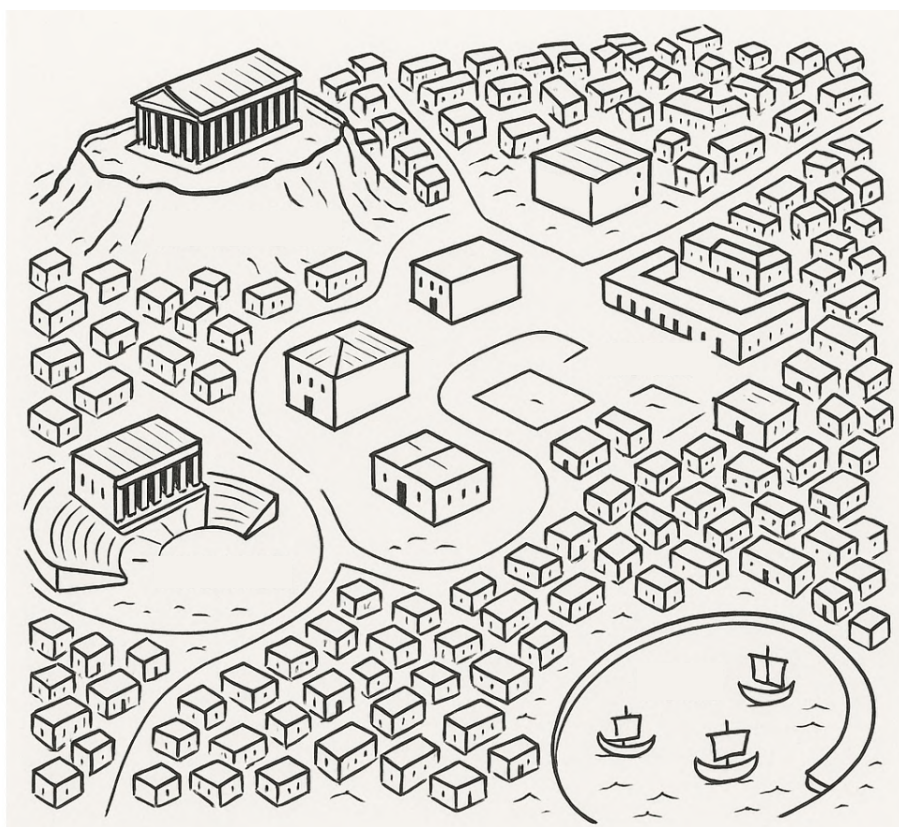
CHARACTER: **CLISTHENES**
