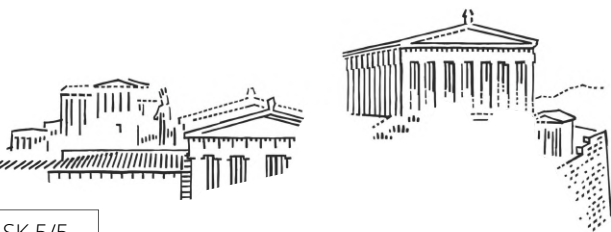

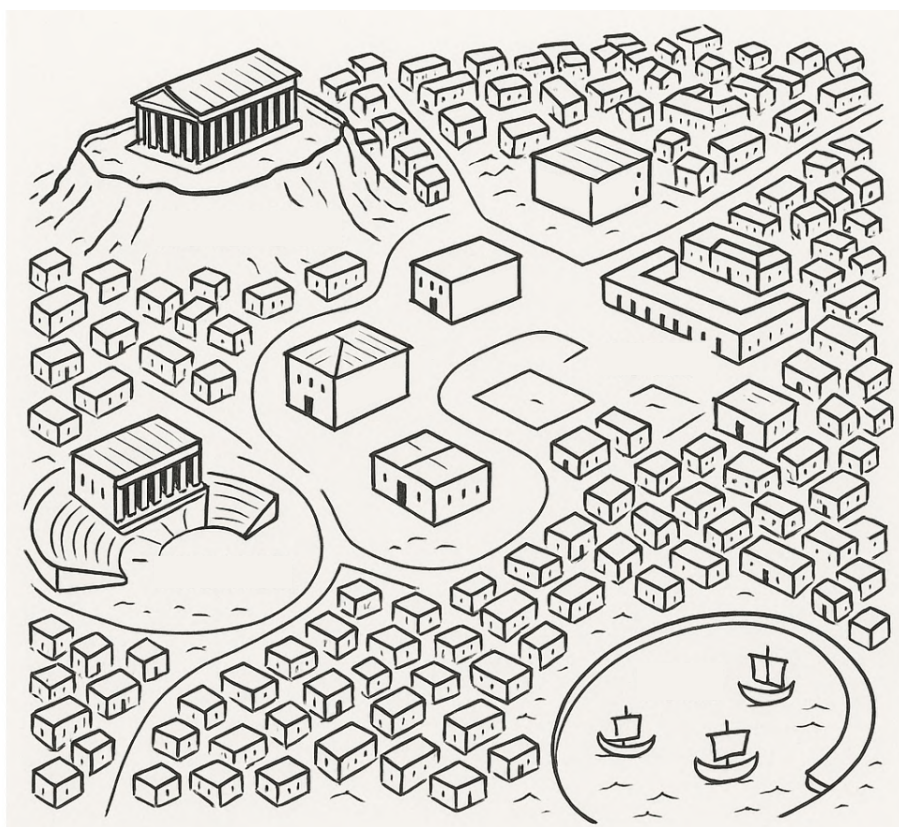
CHARACTER: **PHEIDIPPIDES**
