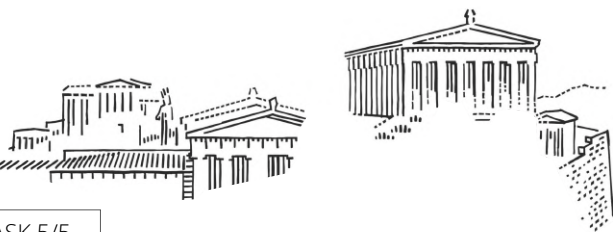

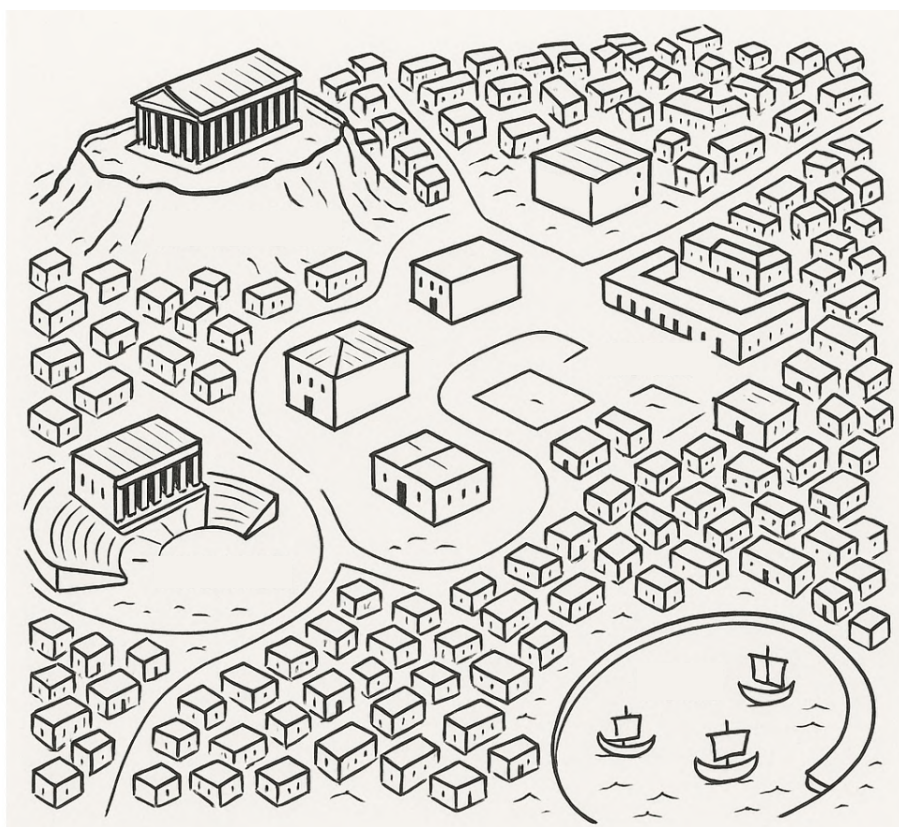
CHARACTER: **TIMEA**
